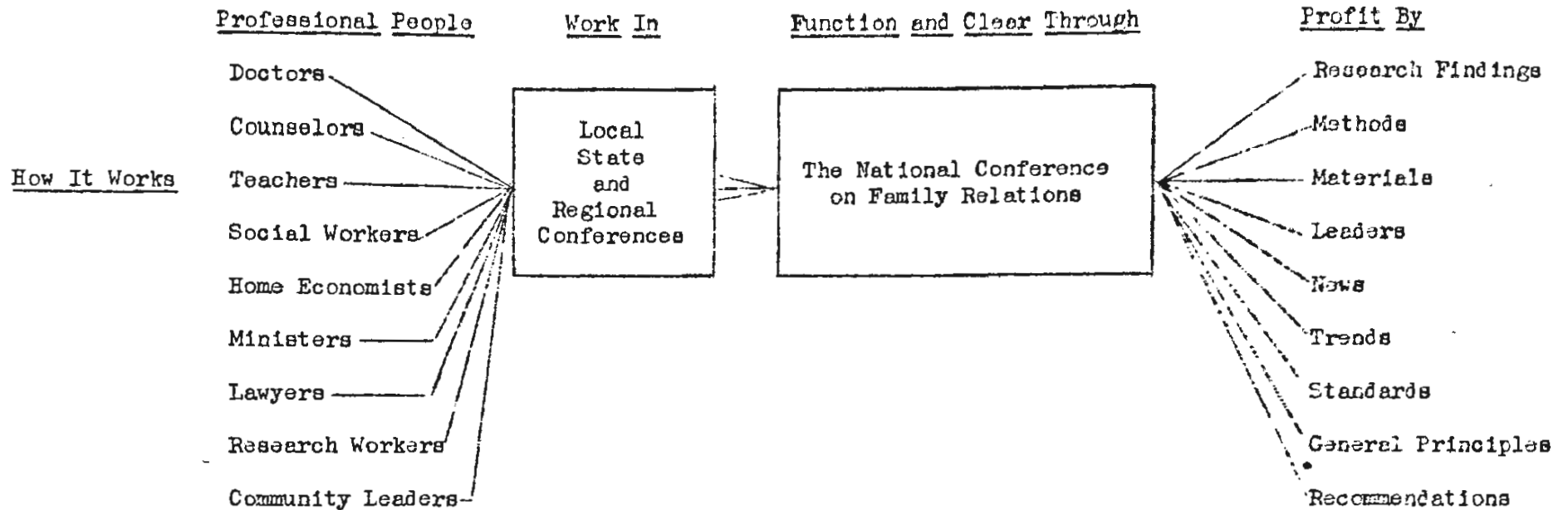

1945-46 The Conference faces the postwar period . . Expands its program to meet
 problems in demobilization and reintegration of the family, Sidney E.
 Goldstein, president. Evelyn Millis Duvall becomes Executive Secretary
